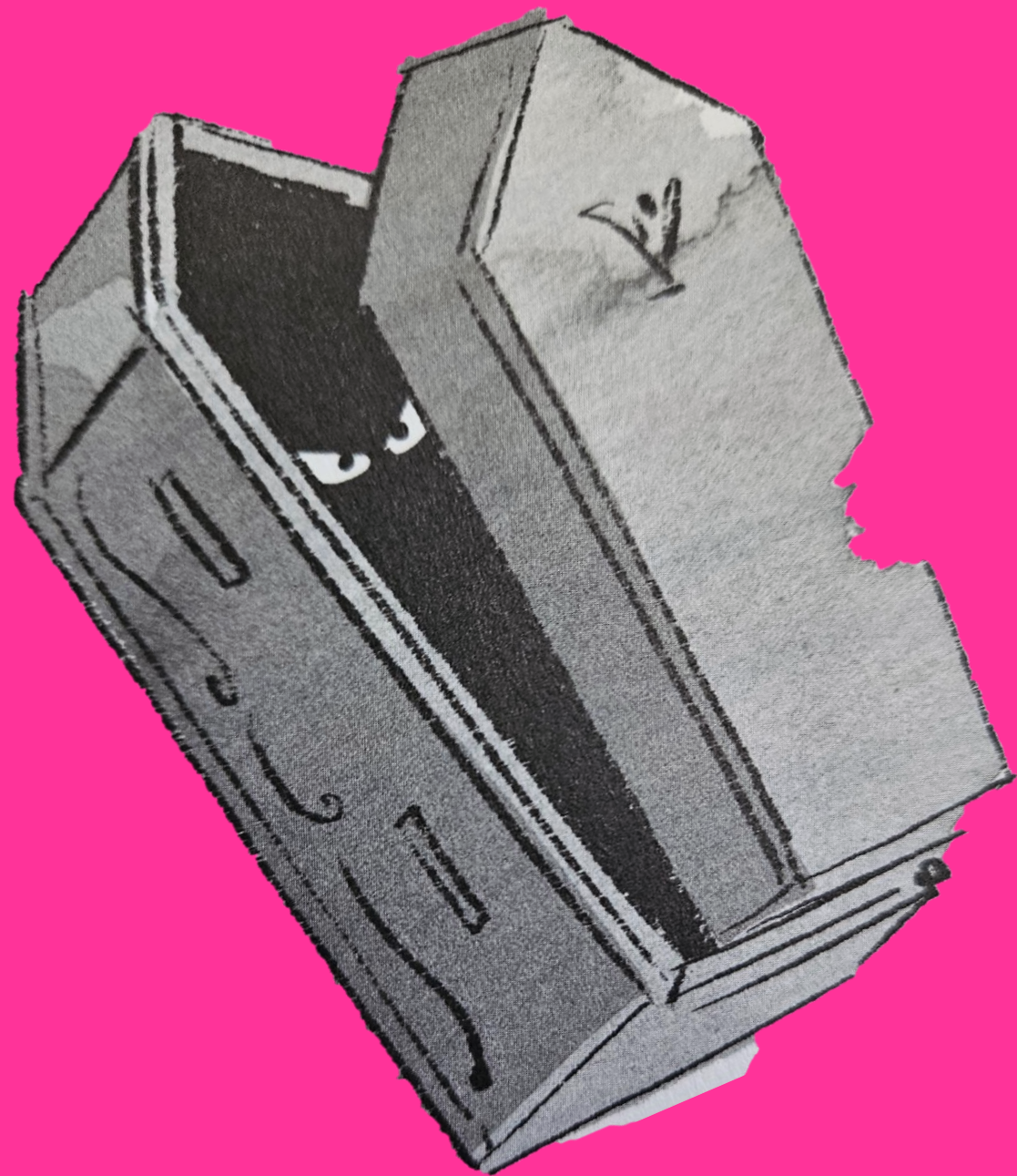

Aggie really does seem to have a lot of catastrophes. Why do you think that is? What advice would you give her?

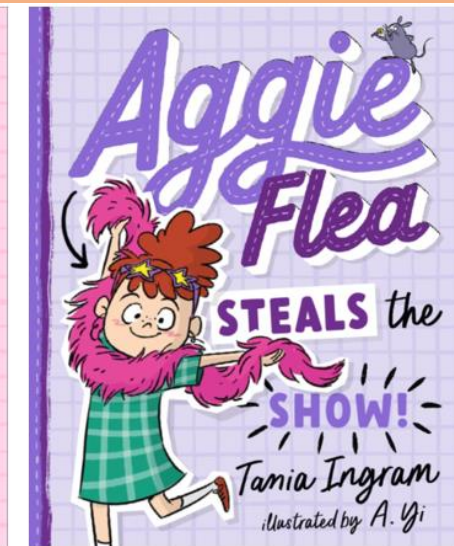
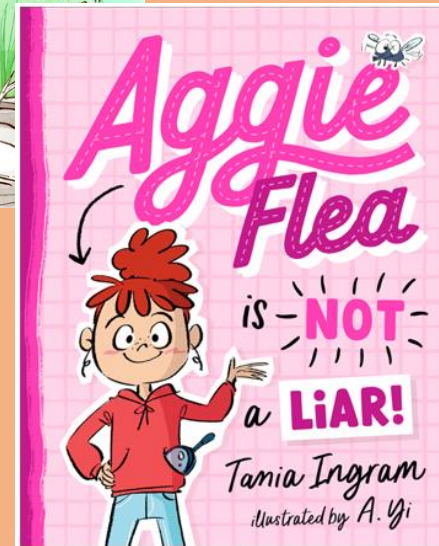
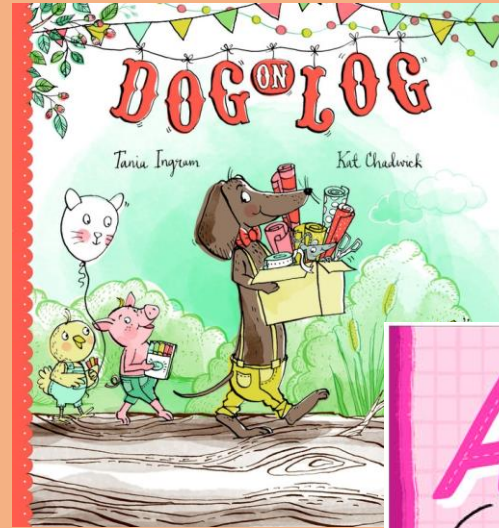
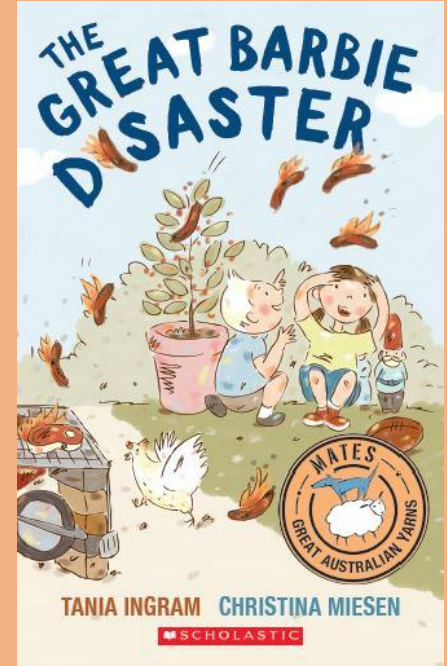
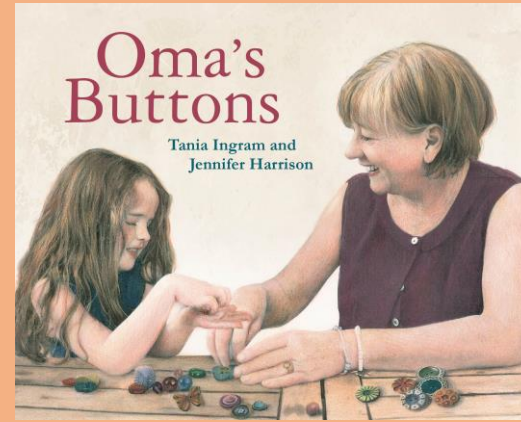
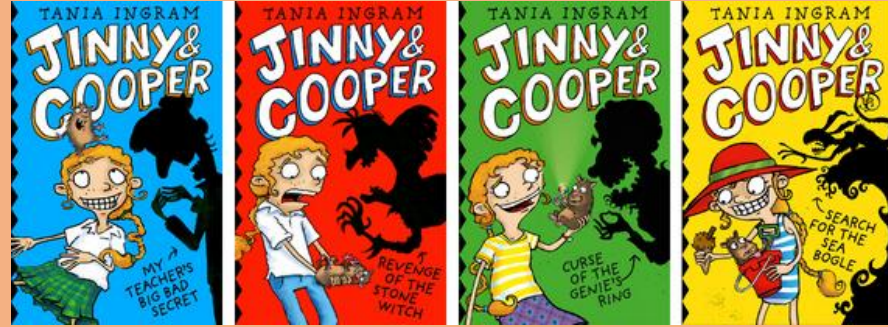
